Sim Tech Academy: A three-day course (maximum of 12 participants) designed for individuals who are in a novice to advanced-beginner sim tech role in their institutions or have been asked to run simulations. The course will provide a hands-on overview of the variety of tools, equipment and troubleshooting techniques involved in high-fidelity simulation. **Course dates: TBA—Portland, Oregon area**
Participants must attend all three days!

Foundations: A two-day overview for up to 15 participants who are novices to simulation. The course focuses on delivering general simulation principles and provides hands-on experience with high-fidelity simulation, and is for those wishing to understand the basic foundations of being an instructor utilizing high-fidelity simulation.

Participants must attend both days!
